Evaluation methodology

The Constituent has vigorous assessment and evaluation processes. The continuous assessment shall include a combination of assignments, case studies, and logbook or project work and the summative assessment shall be done through term end examinations.

The continuous assessment shall not be less than 70% & Term End assessment shall not be less than 30%.

a. Evaluation methodology for Diploma programmes:

- (i) Each Diploma programme shall have 6-8 courses (except contact session). Each course has a continuous and term end assessment component (*as applicable for the programme*):

Continuous Assessment	Term End Assessment
a. Sets of Assignment for theory courses b. Submission (I & II) for Log book / Project / Case Study	a. Term End Examination (TEE) of each theory course b. Submission III (Submission of final Logbook/ Project report/ Case Study)

- (ii) In addition to these courses, **contact session** shall be mandatory non-credit letter grade course. This course shall be awarded grade based of attendance for the session.

- (iii) Learners are requested to appear for the assessments on a timely basis and complete the programme in the stipulated period.

(iv) Assignments are mix of subjective and objective type questions, whereas continuous assessments of case study / logbook / project are devised for imparting practical knowledge required for that particular programme.

(v) These should be completed as per the timelines provided in the Learner handbook. The “formats” of each component is



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available on the student portal. Click

(vi) As a part of term end assessment of practical training courses, learners are also required to submit project, case report and logbook in hard copies II (online through learning management system). Supervised term end examination for each theory course is conducted at designated exam centres.

(vii) Learner, who have submitted all components of continuous assessments applicable to their programme, will be eligible to fill exam form and take the term end examination for the courses.

(viii) Diploma learners will also have to attend a compulsory Contact session (F2F).

(ix) Learner, who have submitted all components of continuous assessments applicable to their programme, will be termed eligible to fill the exam form and take the term end examination for the courses.

(x) The Diploma will be awarded ONLY if, student has completed & secured 50% passing marks in all the elements of assessment & fulfilled all the other criteria laid down by SSODL including payment of all fees.

b. Evaluation methodology for certificate programme:

- (i) Each Certificate programme is shall have 4 courses. Each course has a continuous and term end assessment component (*as applicable for the programme*):

Continuous Assessment	Term End Assessment
a) Assignments b) Case study I	a) Term End Examination (TEE) of each theory course b) Case study II(Submission)

- (ii) Learners are expected to appear for the assessments on a timely basis and complete the programme in the stipulated period.
(iii) Learners are requested to appear for the assessments on a timely basis and complete the programme in the stipulated period.
(iv) Assignments are mix of subjective and objective type questions, whereas continuous assessment for case study, is devised for imparting practical skills required for that particular programme. They should be completed as per the timelines provided in the Learner handbook.
